Talks are free for members. Non-members are welcome. Admission £3

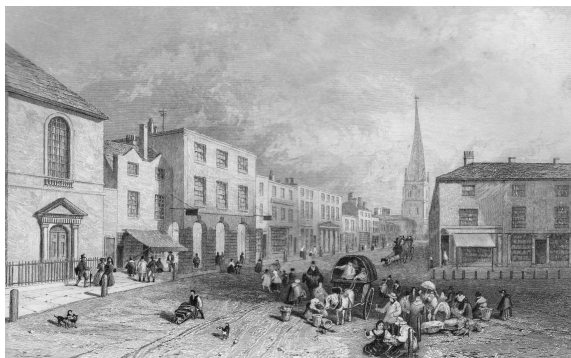

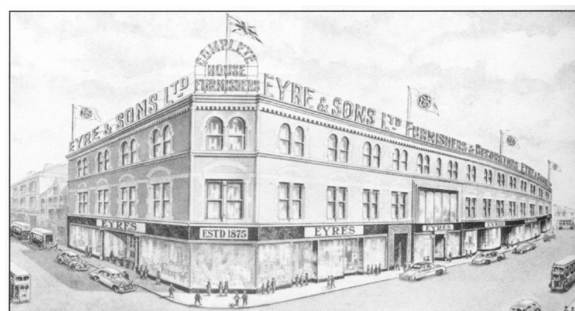
