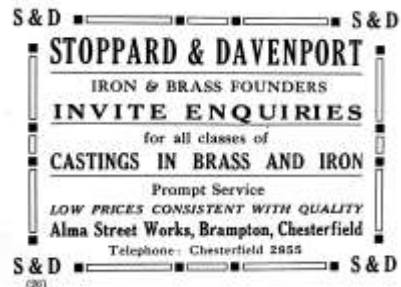

Chesterfield and District Local History Society seeks to encourage public interest in local history particularly of the Chesterfield area.

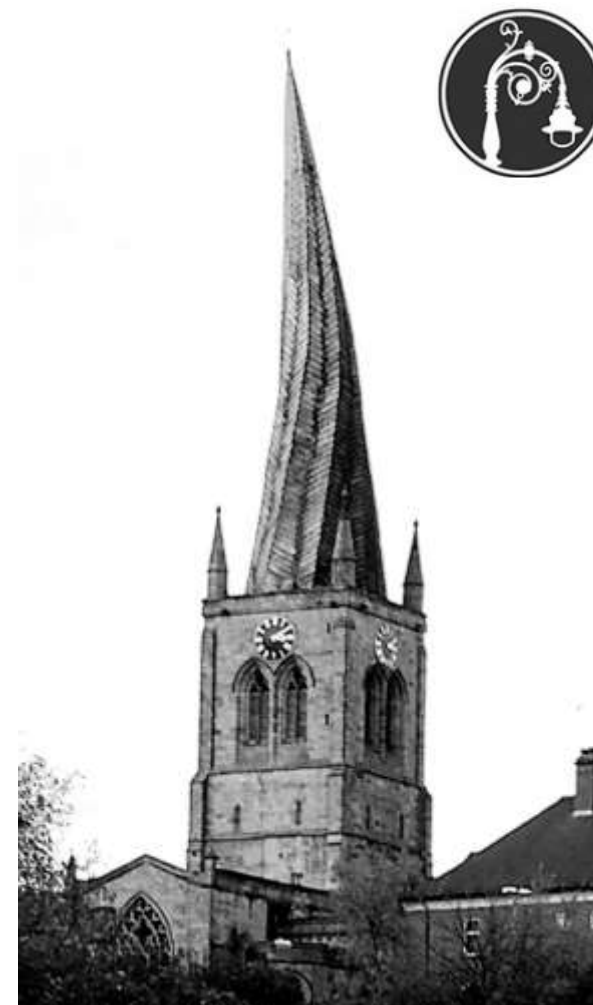
